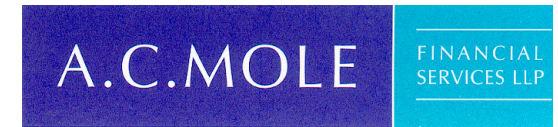


Who are we?

Our resident adviser is Caroline Perry who has over 20 years experience in the financial services industry and holds the specialist qualification for Long Term Care planning.



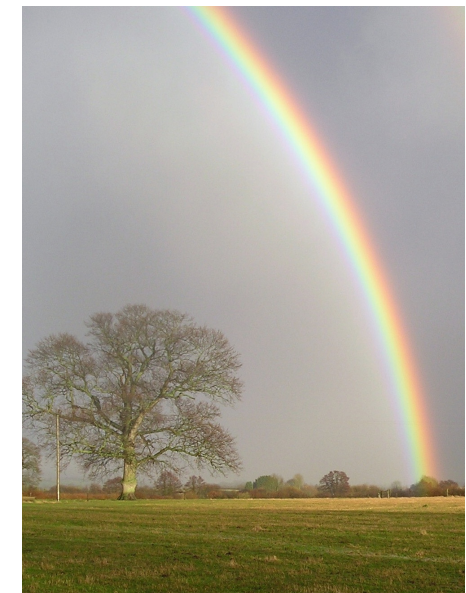
Care Home Funding
